





Objectives:

Drug use distracts attention leading to academic failure and poor social skills. Stress plays a major role in drug use and continuing drug abuse. It also creates problem in our family, school and with our friends. The person's reflexes will become slower; they will have trouble working and doing things which require any physical any mental coordination. In spite of knowing the harmful effects of drugs, people spend lots of money and consume them to forget their worries and sorrows and to seek happiness. Once a person is addicted, it is very hard to stop taking drugs.

Drugs get us involved in many illegal activities such as crime, theft, etc. It leads to sexual assault and accidents. Young people use drugs because of curiosity, peer pressure, boredom, finance problem and for pleasure. The person's behaviors tend to self-destructive activities and are often harder to think clearly and make good decisions.

Effects:

The third component of personal cognitive factors is social persuasion. Social persuasion includes verbal and non-verbal influence of others intended to increase self-efficacy. Laurens school counselors are attempting to increase her self-efficacy by recommending rehab. The school counselors are giving Lauren verbal influence to help herself so she can make better future decisions. The final component is physiological or affective states. Physiological states include heart rate, breathing, pain, or instability. Affective states include the positivity or negativity. Lauren has experienced instability and emotional negativity due to having to move out of the dorms. Since moving out of the dorms, Lauren has experienced emotional taxation because of the additional dependence that comes with living off campus. All the components of the personal cognitive factors lead to Laurens self-efficacy and future behaviors, cognitions, and affect.





Causes of AIR Pollution

Air pollution is caused by the presence in the atmosphere of toxic substances, mainly produced by human activities, even though sometimes it can result from natural phenomena such as volcanic eruptions, dust storms and wildfires, also depleting the air quality.

Anthropogenic air pollution sources are:

- 1. **Combustion of fossil fuels**, like coal and oil for electricity and road transport, producing air pollutants like nitrogen and sulfur dioxide



Reservation in India - group discussion:



Reservation is a system of affirmative action in India that provides historically disadvantaged groups representation in education, employment and politics. Based on provisions in the Indian Constitution, it allows the Union Government and also the States and Territories of India to set reserved quotas or seats, which lower the qualifications needed in exams, job openings and etc. for "socially and educationally backward citizens.

Quota systems favoring certain castes and other communities existed before independence in several areas of British India. Demands for various forms of positive discrimination had been made, for example, in 1882 and 1891.Rajarshi Shahu, the Maharaja of the princely state of Kolhapur, introduced reservation in favor of non-Brahmin and backward classes, much of which came into force in 1902. He provided free education to everyone and opened several hostels to make it easier for them to receive it. He also tried to ensure that people thus educated were suitably employed, and he appealed both for a class-free India and the abolition of untouchability. His 1902 measures created 50 percent reservation for backward communities.
